Worshipping God in new ways

As I write this we are over three weeks into Lockdown a state that may well be with us for several more weeks or months yet – and a state which has become the 'new normal' amazingly quickly. Looking back to the time before the effects of the coronavirus pandemic – a whole new definition of 'BC'! - so much has changed in so short a time....

Laws, which would normally take years to draft, scrutinise and pass are already in force. New ways of shopping, being schooled, interacting with our GPs, spending our spare time.....restrictions on our freedoms that we would never, under normal circumstances, have allowed to be imposed without a fight, have been accepted for the good of the whole community, to preserve the ability of the NHS to cope, for our common good.....

It is a worrying time – no one knows what the future will hold – but in reality no-one has ever known exactly what the future will hold! We fear what may happen to us or to our loved ones, we feel we have no control - the reality is, and always has been, that we have very little control and, ultimately, we will all die....

The experience of the pandemic is a very levelling one – it does not matter how famous you are, or how much money you have, what your job is (or was) or who you know. The impact of it demonstrates to us all what is really important in life – makes us pause and reassess what really matters. This is one of the positives to come out the experiences of the past few weeks. And I hope and pray that we do not forget these lessons when we emerge from lockdown in a few months from now - I hope our realisations of what makes life worth living our relationships with others, our common care and concern -our appreciation of those who serve us, and make our common life possible - will remain as important motivators.

This year we experienced an Easter unlike any other – which has caused us churchy folk to pause – stopped in our tracks – no longer able to all those things we always do – unable to practise the traditions handed down through the generations. So what did we do? We embraced new technology – we now have a new website With love and prayers. - kl.church - we even have a YouTube channel! We used whatever avenues were still open to us (including the old

faithful methods of post and telephone!) to proclaim the Good News of Easter - that God loves us and that death is not the end.....

And some people may be asking 'Where is God in all of this?' One answer lies in the words of the following sonnet, written by Malcom Guite, poet in residence for the 'Church Times', especially for this particular Easter season that we are still in the midst of.

> And where is Jesus, this strange Easter day? Not lost in our locked churches, anymore Than he was sealed in that dark sepulchre. The locks are loosed; the stone is rolled away, And he is up and risen, long before, Alive, at large, and making his strong way Into the world he gave his life to save, No need to seek him in his empty grave.

He might have been a wafer in the hands Of priests this day, or music from the lips Of red-robed choristers, instead he slips Away from church, shakes off our linen bands To don his apron with a nurse: he grips And lifts a stretcher, soothes with gentle hands The frail flesh of the dying, gives them hope, Breathes with the breathless, lends them strength to cope.

On Thursday we applauded, for he came And served us in a thousand names and faces Mopping our sickroom floors and catching traces Of that virus which was death to him: Good Friday happened in a thousand places Where Jesus held the helpless, died with them That they might share his Easter in their need, Now they are risen with him, risen indeed.

It is a strange thing to go from having so much regular contact with people, to potentially not seeing friends, colleagues or young people you work with for months. It is an adjustment that I am still trying to adapt to. However, in some ways I feel more connected to certain people than before. I am producing family activity packs to go on various community groups every other day. I am also chatting with people across these groups using the Easter Conversation Calendar my friend produced. Plus, I am creating a weekly video for toddlers, as a mini attempt to offer a story for the See & Know families, since we are unable to read and interact in person.

I find the interaction that has happened because of the various posts I have been doing on different platforms have felt deeply important. Conversations have sprung up that would not have happened if my job had been as it was a month ago. Things have been lost by the change

to my work, but new opportunities have emerged that feel like a blessing. Unexpected conversations have led to unexpected discussions, sometimes a moment of connection in an otherwise disconnecting day. A feeling of connection with people I know and people I don't.

The online conversations have also taught me a new way of listening. It involves pausing a lot more to try and work out what to type; how to respond well in that moment. As I type I am aware this might be the first interaction for someone that day. It might be mine too. The words we use on the internet are important. We are taught to be careful of the words we say but I think now, more than ever, we need to think more about the words we type. Embracing the pause but also sensing when saying nothing might be the best answer or comment too.

A highlight of my work has been St. Patrick's Youth Groups Games night on Zoom. It was great to hear how everyone was and do something as regular as playing some of the games we normally play at youth group. I think that has been the key thing to hold onto during this odd season, the moments of normality and how life giving those moments are. I suspect after this has all gone, we will embrace and cherish normality much more than we did previously.

Riverside erosion

We are all aware of the ongoing erosion of the western bank of the Lune between Devil's Bridge and the Radical steps. And, of course, the significant costs involved in maintaining the footpath. I understand plans are afoot to strengthen the riverbank involving gabions. I would be interested if other solutions to the problem have been addressed other than reinforcing the west bank.

Opposite the Radical Steps the river splits into eastern and western channels with the latter taking most of the flow. One possibility to consider would be to make the eastern channel take more of the flow thus alleviating erosion on the west bank. It would also be interesting if any residents have noticed over the years any changes at the location where the river splits around the island. It advance payments for sessions or lessons when we recould be that there has been a build-up of gravel and pebbles which has reduced the flow of the river into the eastern channel?

The Cumbria County Council emergency helpline has been set up to deal with people who are at high risk and self-isolating, not in the 'shielded' category but those who have no family, friends, neighbours or other local support to call on. The County Council has linked with the network of Local Volunteer hubs such as the Kirkby Lonsdale Community Hub and will refer people first to these local groups.

'Those at high risk include people over 70 years old, pregnant women and those with underlying health conditions who should be protecting themselves by staying at home.'

If they have no alternative means of support, these people will now be able to call the Freephone number to request help with getting food, medicines, essential supplies and home deliveries. The County Council Emergency telephone support line is 0800 783 1966.

The telephone 'call centre' will operate Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm and 10am to 2pm at weekends. The service will also accept referrals from members of the public who may be concerned about people in their community.

The new NHS volunteers are being directed to support the 1.5m people who are 'shielded', in other words have been identified across the UK by GPs as extremely at risk. Those in this category should have received a letter from the government stating that they will receive free food parcels if needed and have help with medicine delivery and loneliness. People who believe they are in this category who may not have had a letter, can self-register on the Government website https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus-extremely-vulnerable or by calling 0800 028 8327.

- ask friends, family and delivery services to deliver things like food shopping and medicines but leave them outside

- do not have visitors to your home (ask people to leave deliveries outside)
- do not leave your home, for example to go to work, school, or public areas, and do not use public transport or taxis.
- If possible, you should not go out even to buy food or other essentials, other than exercise, and in that case at a safe distance from others.

Stay at home if you have coronavirus symptoms.

Stay at home if you have either:

You do not need to contact 111 to tell them you're staying at home. Testing for coronavirus is not needed if you're staying at home.

How long to stay at home:

Following the announcement by the RFU that all rugby is cancelled for the 2019/20 season, we have been considering how we can plan for the immediate future.

Our greatest challenge is the loss of revenue from scheduled annual events like the Beer and Music Festival and from welcoming campers to the grounds in the summer months. The impact of these cancellations on our cashflow affecting our ability to meet current financial liabilities/ongoing running/maintenance costs is significant. We are trying to balance our moral and financial obligations while securing the future of KLRUFC.

Securing the future of our Club.

- 1. The Management Committee are in discussions with our insurers to determine if we are covered for business interruption linked to the virus and the Government decree to enforced closure of the Club.
- 2. Close liaison with the RFU to ensure we have access to any funding and support packages that are available.
- 3. Grant application submitted to SLDC via Government initiative to support social clubs and hospitality.
- 4. We have furloughed our salaried staff and are using the Government Salary Guarantee Scheme to reduce our outgoings and protect these positions for when we can recommence our activities.
- 5. We have set up a Just Giving page. We recognise the financial difficulties many of us are facing at present, but any donations, however small, will help us through this unprecedented time. Please go to https://www.justgiving.com/crowdfunding/klrufc.

To end on a more cheerful note, our Senior teams have had a good season this year. The 1st XV Men and Ladies will be playing in the same leagues next season.
